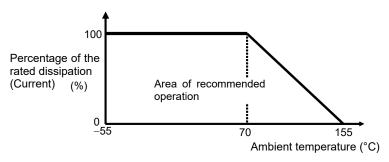


Figure-1 Derating curve

- 8). The resistors shall be faced to upward at the over coating side in the carrier cavity.

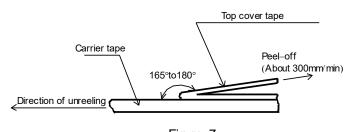
